Hotel and playing hall

Extra accomodation

For parents, siblings, extra coaches, players from Faroe Islands, etc, the price including full board (dinner Thursday, breakfast, lunch and dinner Friday and Saturday, breakfast and lunch Sunday) is: In triple room: SEK 2.400/person, in double room: SEK 2.700/person and in single room: SEK 3.900/person. Local travels between the hotel and the playing hall are included.

Regulations

The teams are qualified through the national federation's scholastic chess championships in each country. Both groups will play five rounds (round robin). The time control is 90 min per game with an additional 30 sec per move starting from the first move.
