## 100 Years Kriegshaber Chess Club

Augsburg/Germany, 14th - 15th sept. 2024

### **Historical:**

*On the 4th of July 1924 the Kriegshaber Chess Club was founded in Augsburg. Since then it exists continuously under this name as an independent club. The contemporary city district of Kriegshaber got incorporated into the city of Augsburg only eight years before the foundation of the club.*

*Research on the former community name „Kriegshaber“ cannot answer its origin with certainty until today.*

*Having currently more than 140 registered members the Kriegshaber Chess Club nowadays is one of the biggest chess societies in Swabia (a part of Bavaria/Germany).*

On occasion of the centennial of its foundation the Kriegshaber Chess Club hosts a Jubilee-Rapid-Tournament under the following rules from 2024-09-14 to 2024-09-15:

**PLAYING VENUE:** 86159 Augsburg, Goegginger Str. 10, Kongress am Park (Congress Centre)

Caution, there are only a few parking spaces in close proximity of the Congress Centre. Free Parking is available in front of the sports hall „Erhard Wunderlich“ (sat nav: Augsburg, Ulrich-Hofmaier-Str. 30). Distance to the playing venue about 550 meters.

**ORGANIZATION:** Mr. Christian Hilfrich

**MODE, RULE SET:** 11 rounds Swiss System according to the FIDE Laws of Chess (with appendix A + A5 for rapid chess). Ranking for the 1st round will be determined by FIDE-Rating (ELO), alternatively by national rating. Default time according to article 6.7.1 FIDE-LoC is 10 minutes. Leaderboards and pairings will be announced on [chess-results.com](http://chess-results.com).

**TIME LIMIT:** 15 min/game + 5 sec increment/move

3. Sonneborn-Berger-Score
4. Summarized Buchholz.
5. By lot.
